Humble Beginnings

Following humble beginnings almost 31 years ago, Joy Junction is now New Mexico's largest homeless shelter. We provide emergency food, clothing, programs, and lodging to approximately 300 men, women, children, and families on a daily basis.

Hot Meals

Joy Junction serves approximately 16,000 meals per month from our shelter, including 6,000 meals from our Lifeline of Hope mobile food truck. Joy Junction has a mandate to provide a hand up to those who are in need.

At first level, Joy Junction meets the basic needs of food, clothing, and shelter for each guest. Spiritually, it is Joy Junction's mission to provide hope and show love to every guest, and to provide teaching and other opportunities to develop a personal relationship with God.



Life Recovery

Our guests are invited to participate in a nine-month life recovery program that offers help to recover from addictions and to obtain a strong spiritual foundation. Program participants are trained in various life skills and prepared to reintegrate into mainstream society and find employment.



Many graduates are assisted in finding entry level jobs. Temorpary housing at Joy Junction allows them to work for a time before reintegrating into mainstream society. In this way, Joy Junction provides a hand up and helps to break the cycle of homelessness for many of our guests.

Break the Cycle

Joy Junction is 100% donor funded and operates on a 52-acre parcel of land in Albuquerque's South Valley. It has served as our base of operations for almost 31 years.

An unforgiving economy has increased the challenging nature of providing services to needy men, women, children, and families. More and more people are coming to our doors for help.

Our facilities are at capacity with some buildings in need of repair. Joy Junction directors, executives, and staff have been overwhelmed with a burden to expand and renovate facilities and to provide new programs and assistance to those in need.

A Call to Action

It is heartrending to turn away those in need when we are at full capacity. We feel an obligation to provide more beds, a move that will allow us to provide basic care and offer a hand up to those who are still on the streets.



The need has been so great that we are in the midst of constructing an apartment complex to accommodate more people. Some rooms will offer an adjoining door for larger family needs.





Capacity Plus

Our 10,000 sq. ft. multi-purpose building or "Multi" could perhaps be more aptly named the "All Purpose Building," as it receives continual use at Joy Junction. Currently, the Multi serves as the dining and food preparation facility for approximately 16,000 hot meals per month (including about 6,000 meals for the Lifeline of Hope truck), and houses the largest bathroom and shower area available to our guests.



The Multi is being set up with floor mats on a daily basis for guests who are not able to be placed in a dorm, barracks, or elsewhere. The Multi also houses the front office, program office, staff offices, and other general purpose areas. All Bible studies, chapel services, spiritual activities, and other teachings are presently conducted in the Multi.

Compassion

We strongly believe that you and others like you who share our compassion for the poor and needy, can help us to fulfill our mission and vision to expand.

Joy Junction is supported entirely by the generosity of community-minded individuals, churches, and businesses. We do not receive any government funding. Support comes through cash donations, goods and services, donations of vehicles, and revenues from our thrift store and parking lot.
