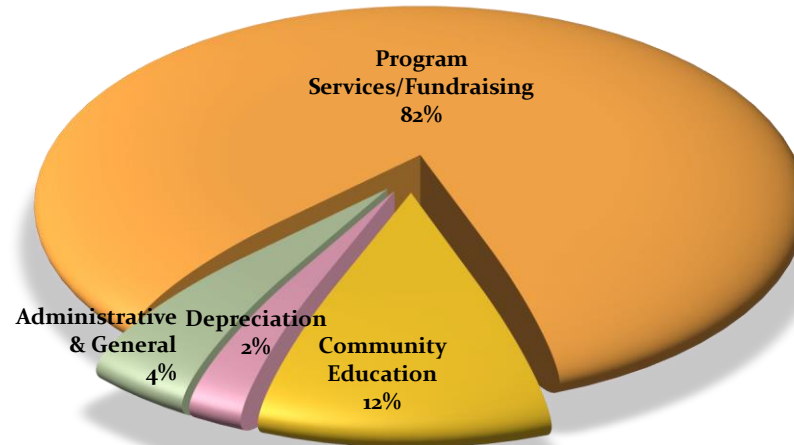


### Joy Junction Mission Statement

### Joy Junction 2017 Highlights

In 2017, Joy Junction served hundreds of thousands of meals in total, and provided as many as 100,000 nights of safe, warm shelter. Our Li feline of Hope mobile food outreach was out on the streets of Albuquerque 7 days a week providing food and encouragement, and our annual Thanksgiving & Christmas Homeless Feast events served thousands of hungry persons at the Albuquerque Convention Center.

As many as 200 homeless individuals attended our nine month life recovery program, featuring a Biblical life recovery program, life skills and more, designed to offer a hand-up, not a hand-out. Upon graduation, many program participants are ready to return to mainstream society.

From a financial and stewardship perspective, the percentage of administrative and general expenses has fallen or remained stable for the tenth straight year. One hundred percent of the revenue received by Joy Junction comes from non-government sources: individuals, churches, businesses and foundations. Thank you for your support!
