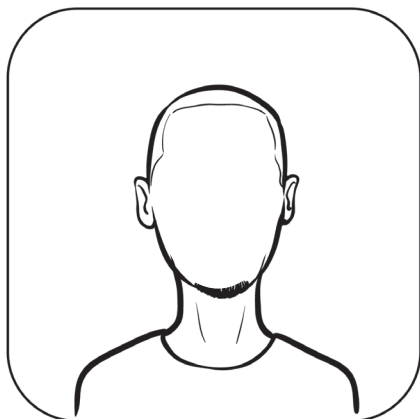

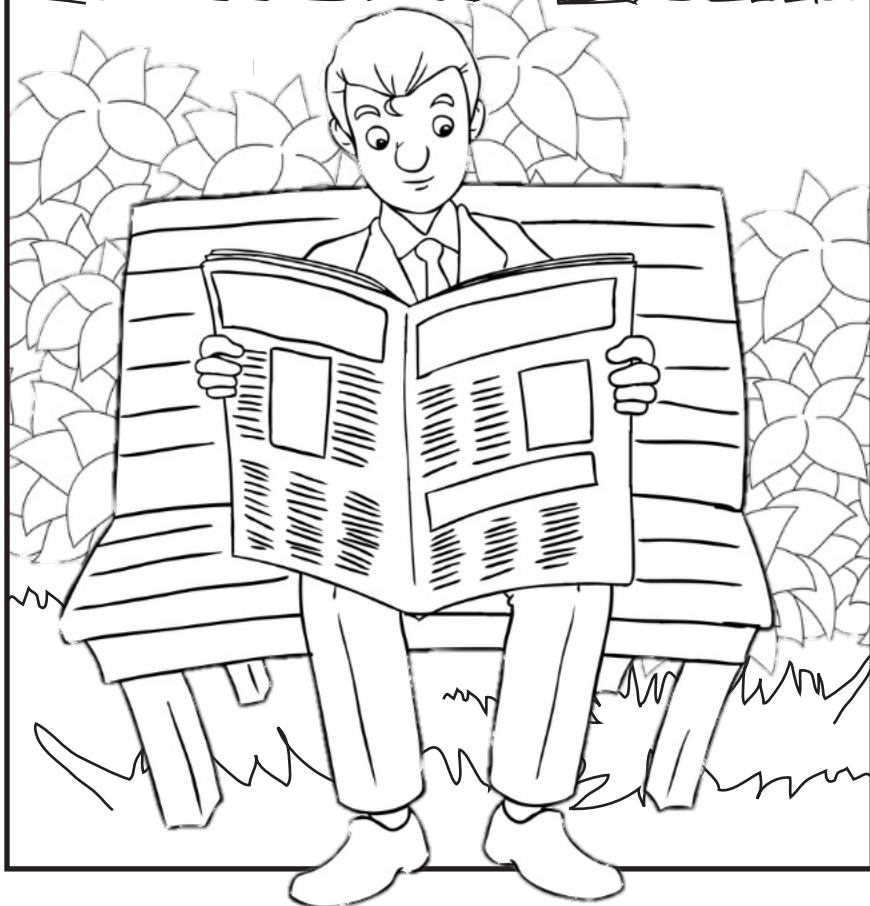

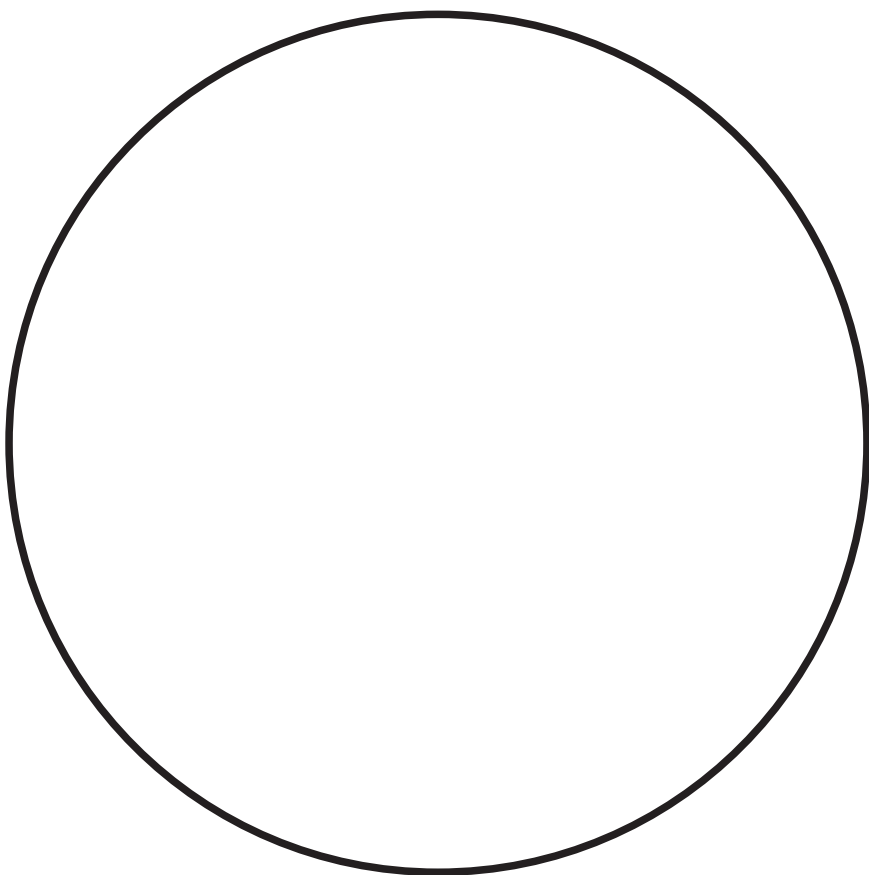
Draw a face on each person that shows what a homeless person might feel after learning that Joy Junction can help them.

Joy Junction serves meals three times a day to any who are hungry.

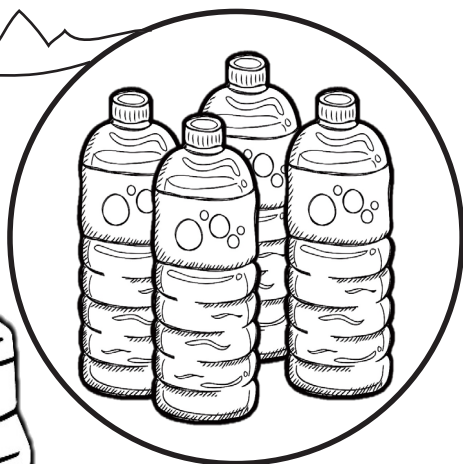

Did you know large items can be picked up by our truck to be delivered to our thrift store? Circle your favorite piece of furniture and then color them all.

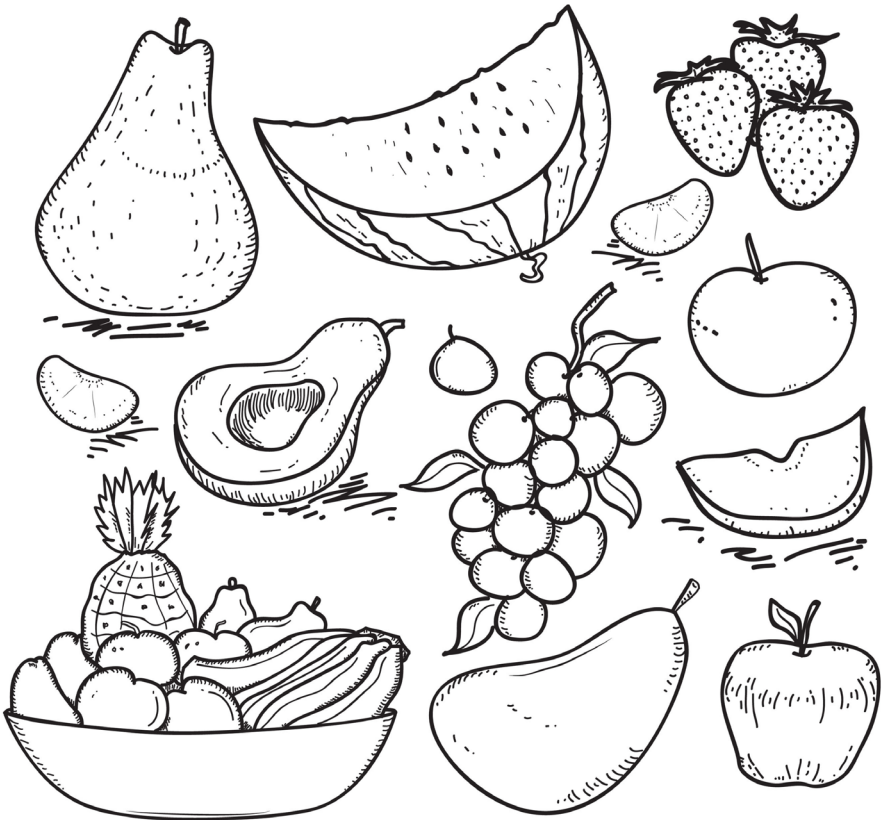

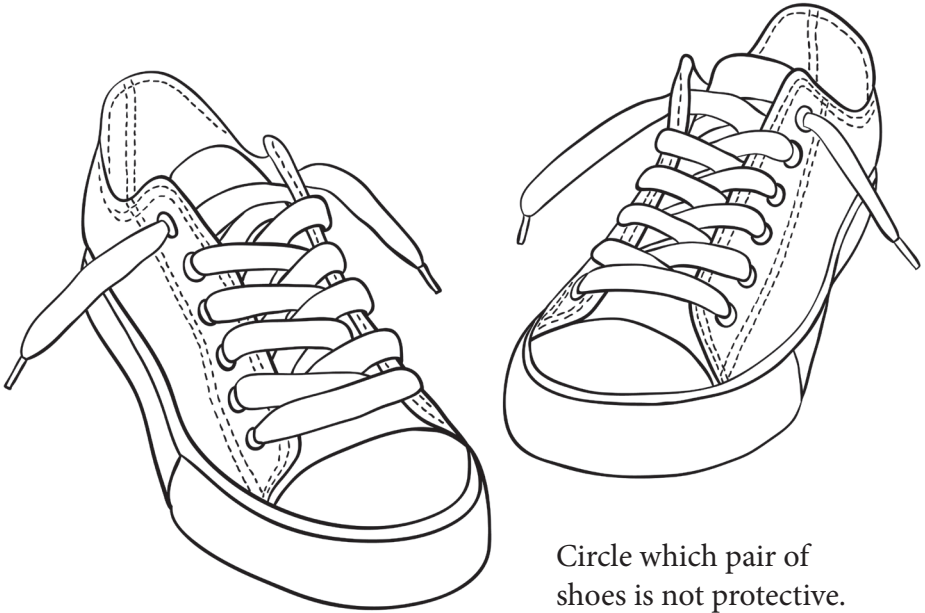

Circle which pair of shoes is not protective.

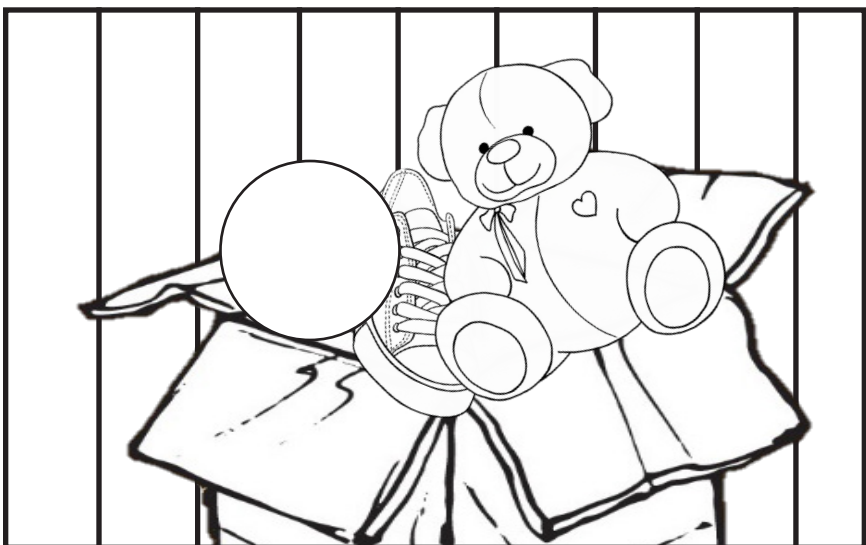
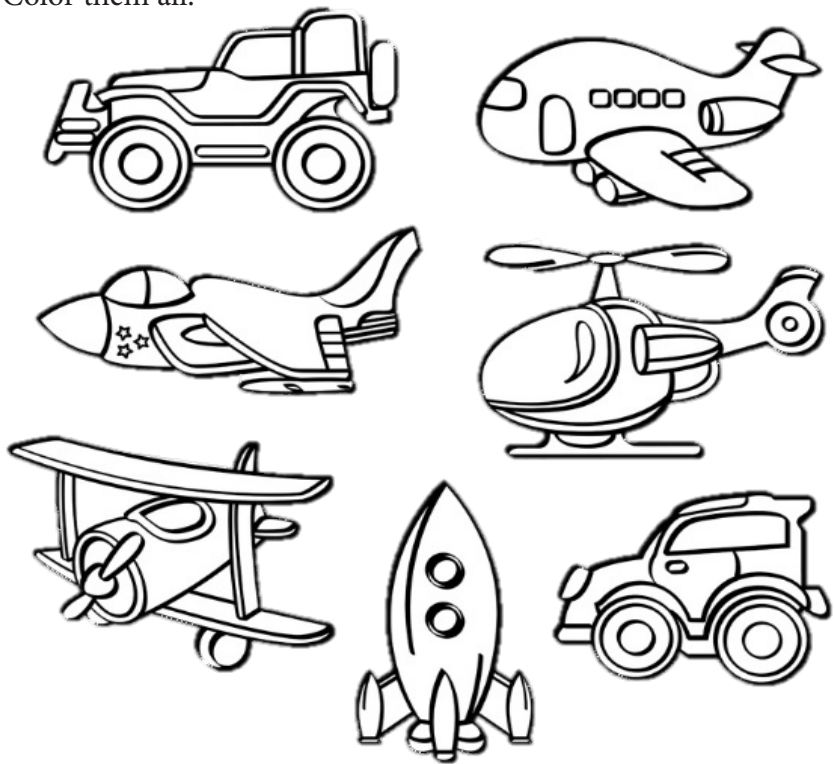

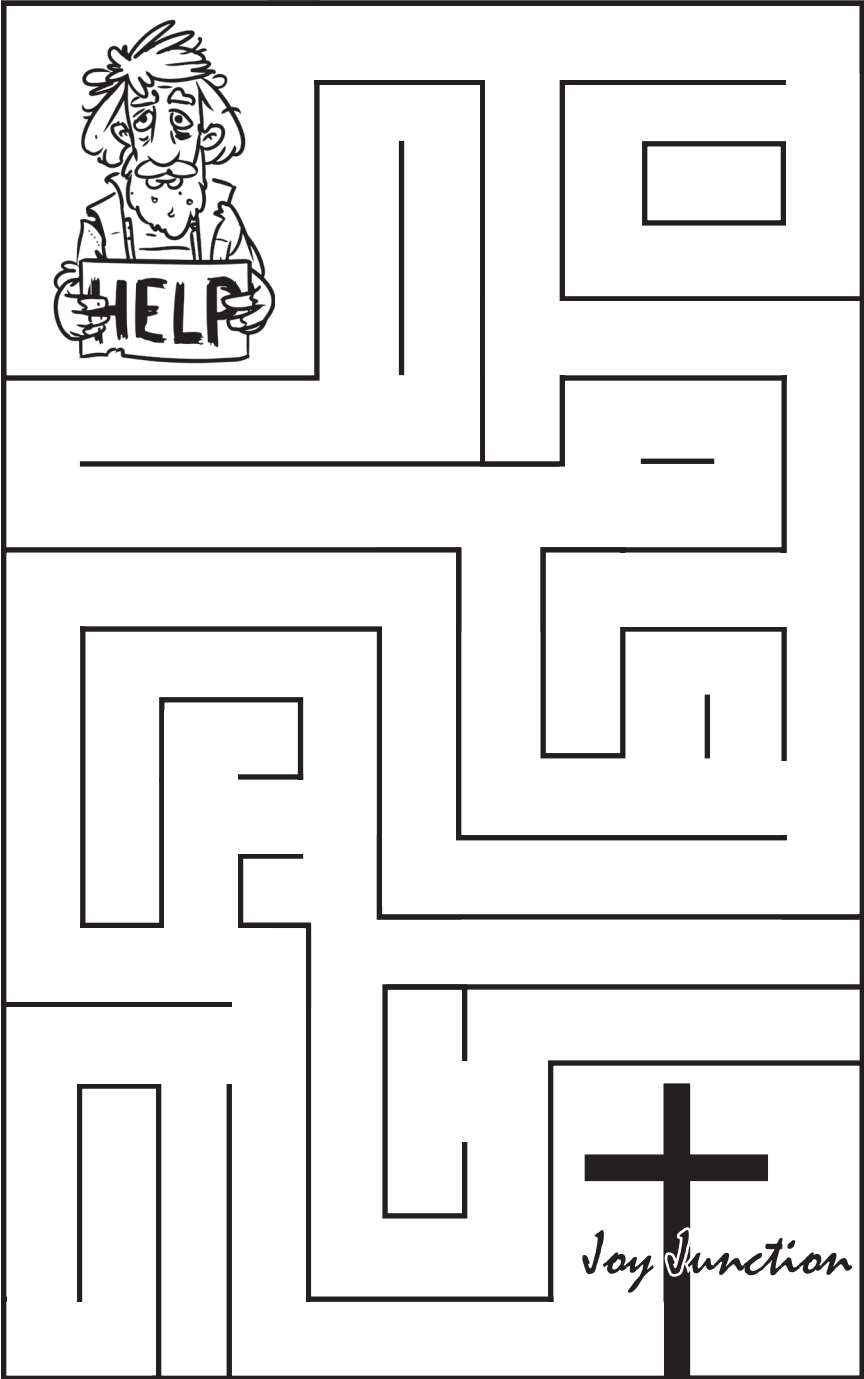
When it's time to clean out the closets, please think of donating items in good condition to Joy Junction. Circle the toy you like best. Color them all.



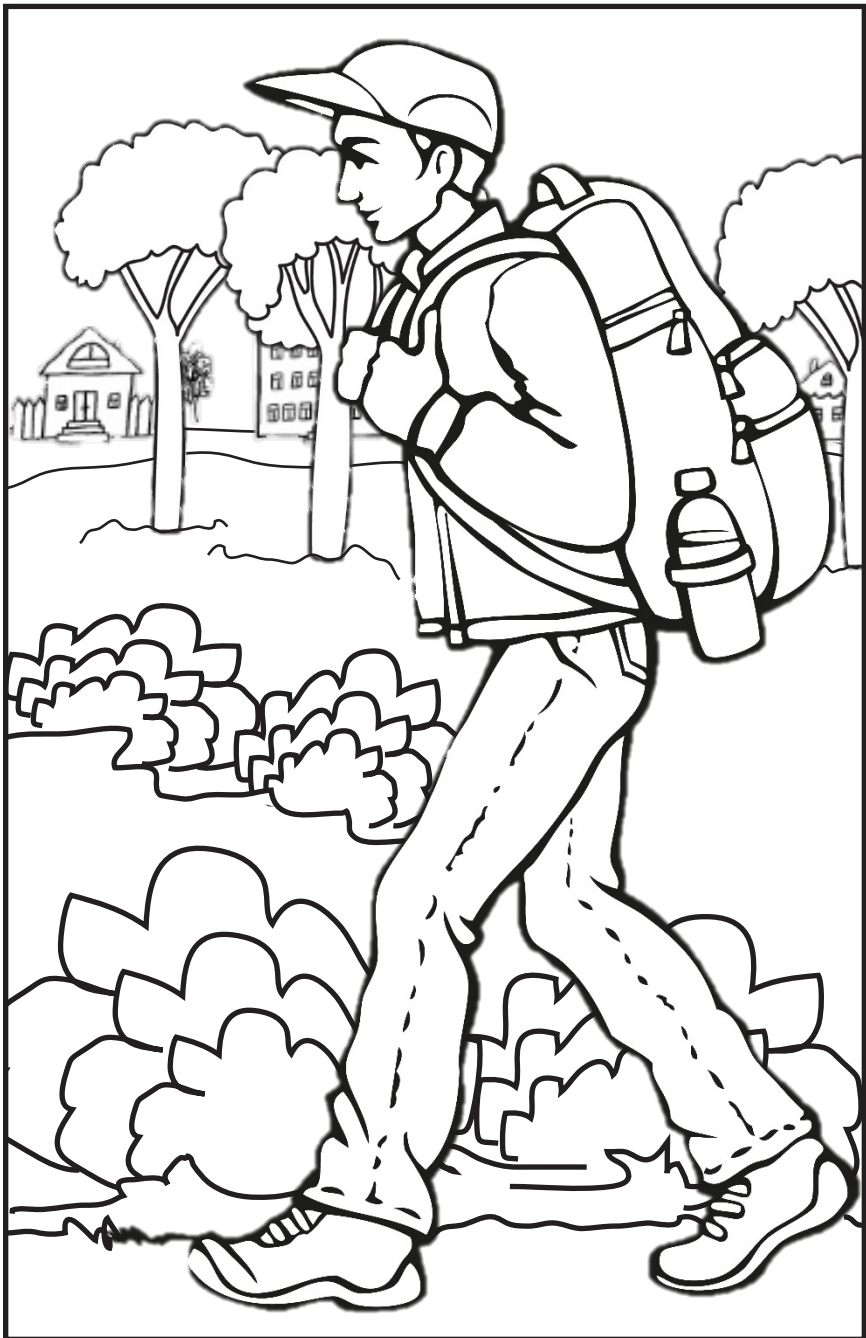
Some days can seem to last forever when you are homeless. Pray for those you see on the streets.



Draw a path to help the homeless man find his way to Joy Junction.



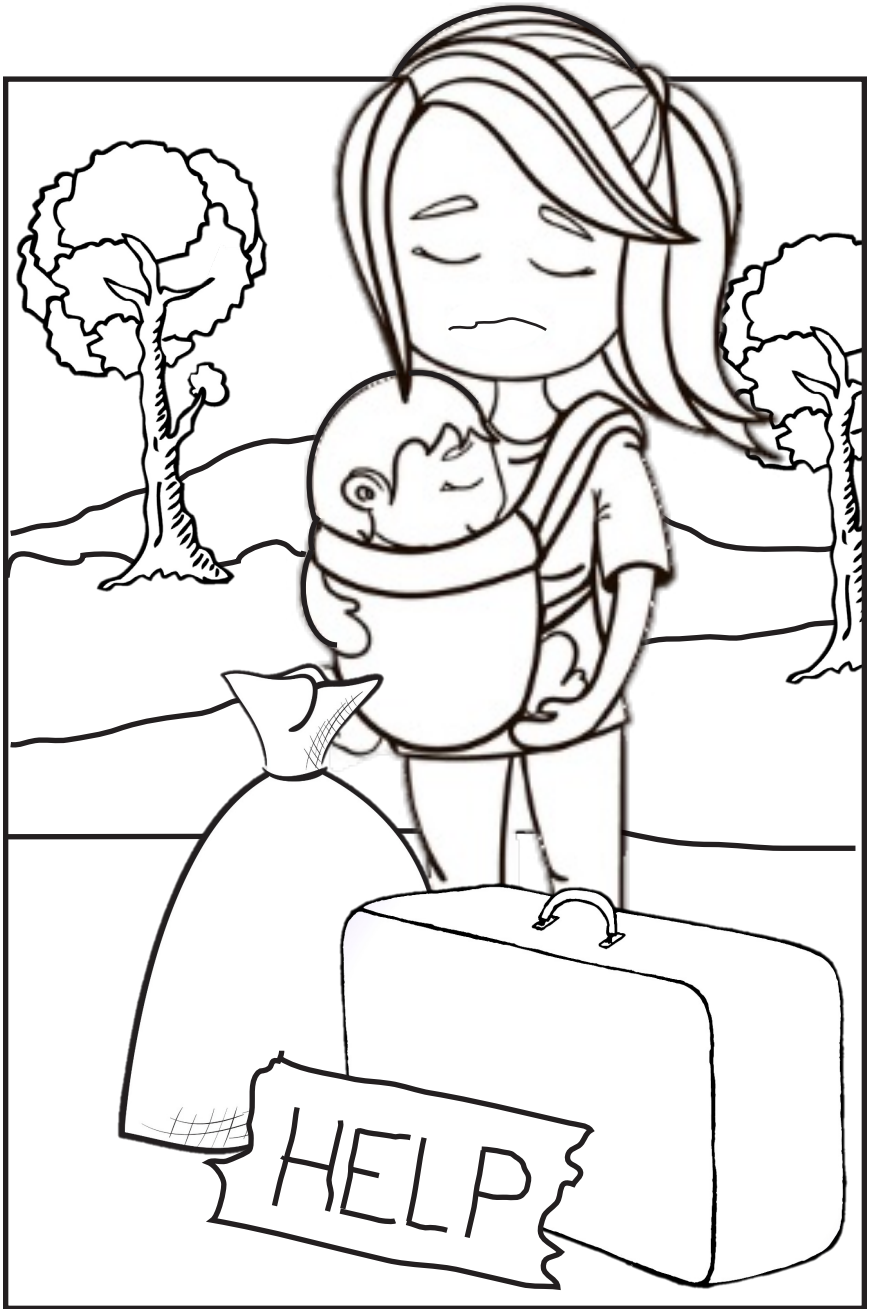
Walking, walking, walking...being without a home is a long, hard journey. Joy Junction provides a safe place to stay.



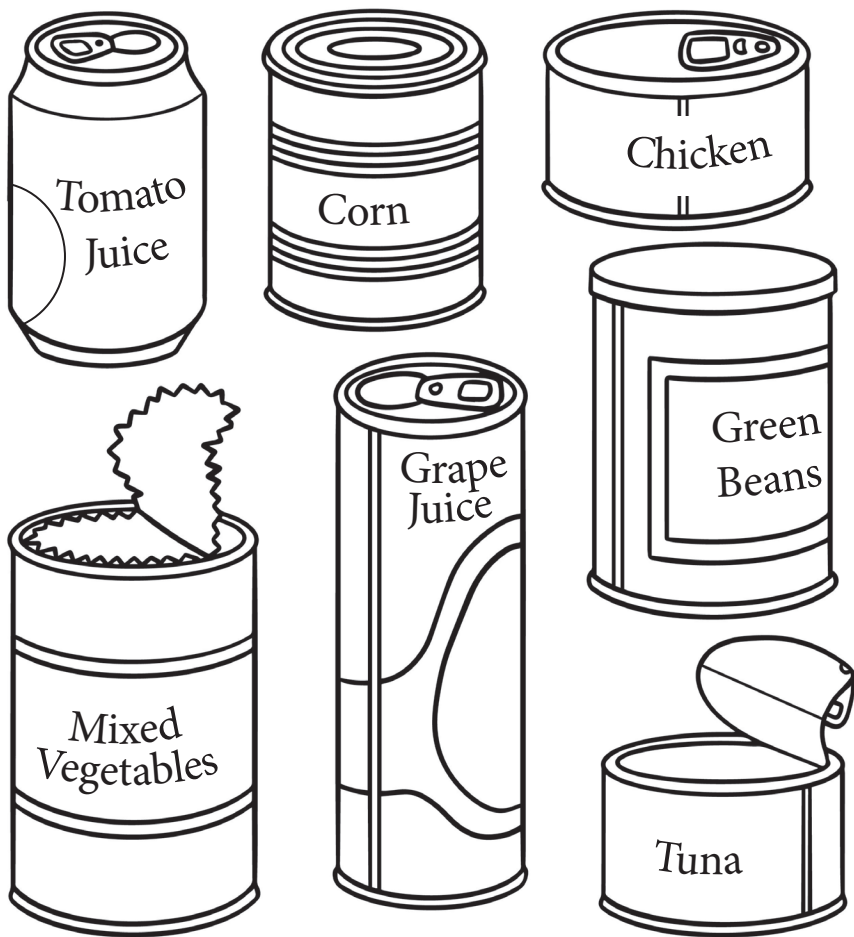
Circle the house you like best. Color them pretty as future homes for Joy Junction families.

To volunteer at Joy Junction, you must first attend a one-time short orientation at 11AM, Monday — Friday. Come as often as you'd like.

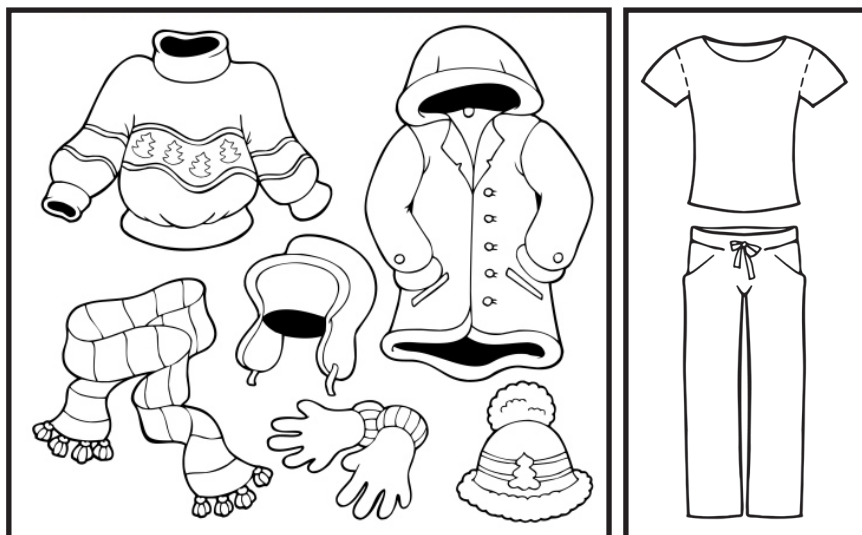
