



Circle which piece of clothing you think would help a homeless person the most in cold weather. Color them all.






Homelessness happens unexpectedly. Compassion goes a long way toward encouraging those found in such a situation.


Did you know large items can be picked up by our truck to be delivered to our thrift store? Circle your favorite piece of furniture and then color them all.

We gladly accept fresh fruit. Circle the type of fruit you like best. Color them all.





Sleeping outside is fun when you are camping...but not so much when you are homeless.




Shoes always come in handy for the homeless. If you have any extra around the house, please think about donating to Joy Junction. Color each pair.






When it's time to clean out the closets, please think of donating items in good condition to Joy Junction. Circle the toy you like best. Color them all.




Some days can seem to last forever when you are homeless. Pray for those you see on the streets.



Color a path to help the homeless man find his way to Joy Junction.




Walking, walking, walking...being without a home is a long, hard journey. Joy Junction provides a safe place to stay.




Circle the house you like best. Color them pretty for future homes for Joy Junction families.

If you have a chance, buy a few extra cans of groceries for Joy Junction when you are at the store. Color each one, then circle your favorite.




We gratefully accept canned goods and USDA approved meat and dairy products. Please deliver to 4500 2nd Street SW., 8AM - 8PM.

Unexpected things happen sometimes... Joy Junction provides three meals a day and a warm, safe place for shelter.




Do you know of anyone who needs to get rid of a vehicle? It can be donated to Joy Junction to help the homeless. Color the vehicles below.



Even if it needs to be towed, Joy Junction will gladly take it. Call 800-924-0569 for more information.


To volunteer at Joy Junction, you must first attend a one-time short orientation at 11AM any day of the week. Come as often as you'd like.








Homeless people would love to have their own home again. What's missing from each house? Write the answers on the blanks below. Then, draw the missing pieces.
